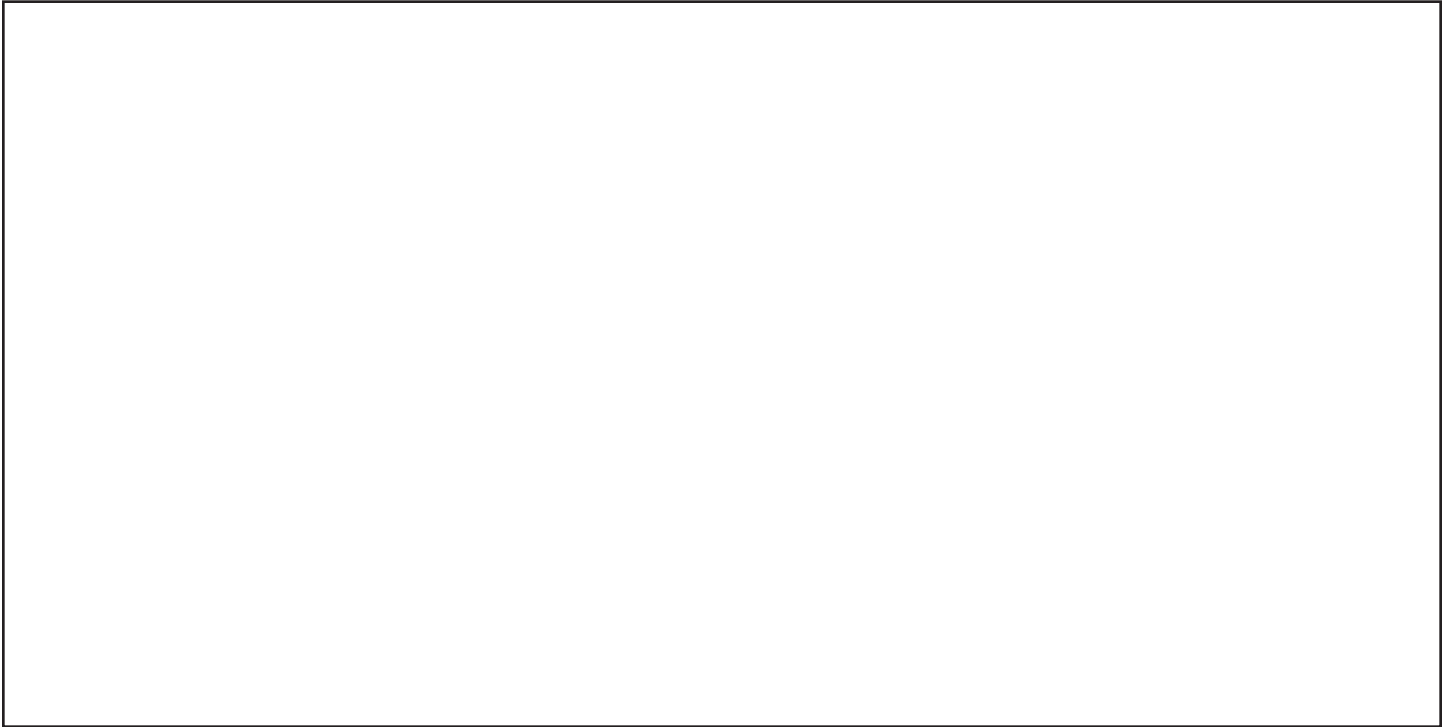
Imagine a community that is safe and free of violence-

Draw what that would look like here.

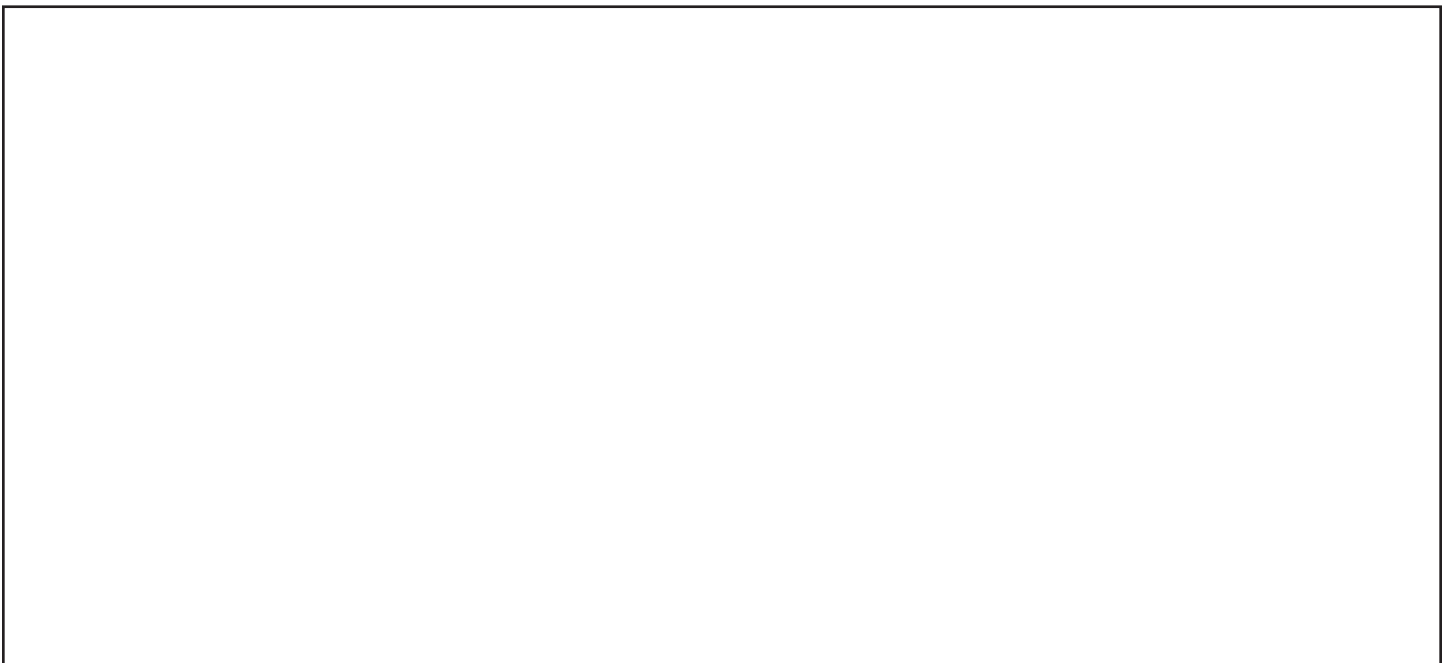
